4

First aid measures

4.1 Description of first aid measures

General information:

In case of excessive inhalation, take the person to fresh air and keep them in a resting position. Consult a doctor.

Remove contaminated clothing immediately, wash the skin with water and soap, and rinse thoroughly for at least 20 minute. If irritation persists or if lesions appear, consult a doctor.
